- The Dwight A. Merriman Charitable Foundation is a Delaware nonstock nonprofit corporation. The Reporting Person is deemed to have voting and investment power over the shares of the Issuer's Class A Common Stock held by the Dwight A. Merriman Charitable Foundation, but has no pecuniary interest in these shares.
